

Animal Care tasks















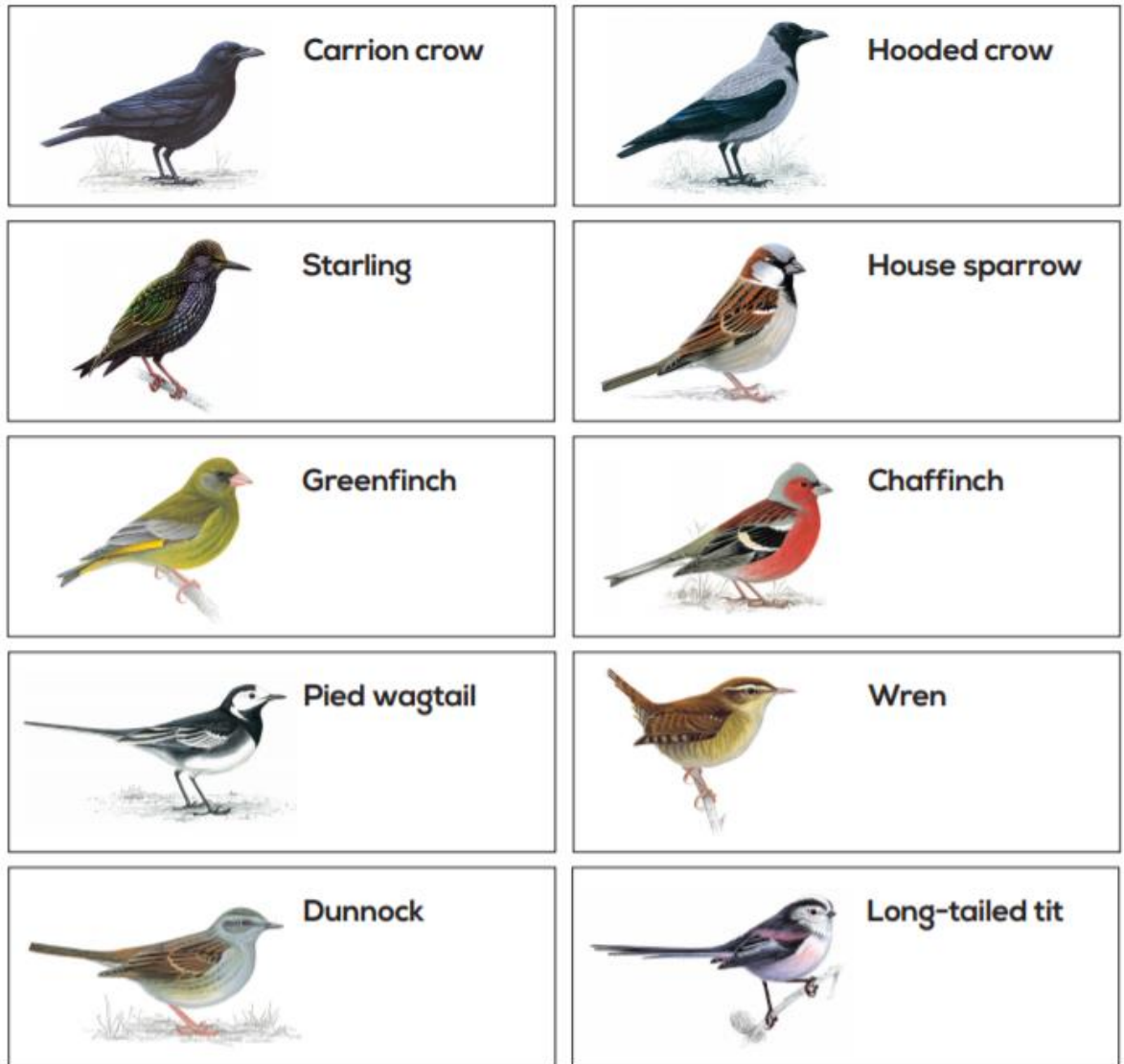
These are a range of tasks that you can do at home. If you have a garden or access to an outside area there are lots of animal related activities you can do.

Task one

Each day spend 20 - 30 minutes looking out of a window on to a garden / park/ field. Record what birds you see.

Can you find a way to make it easier for you to note down the highest number of each species that you **see together at the same time**? There is room below each bird's name for you to add your idea for doing this.

 Collared dove	 Feral pigeon
 Robin	 Blackbird
 Great tit	 Song thrush
 Coal tit	 Blue tit
 Magpie	 Jackdaw

Task 2

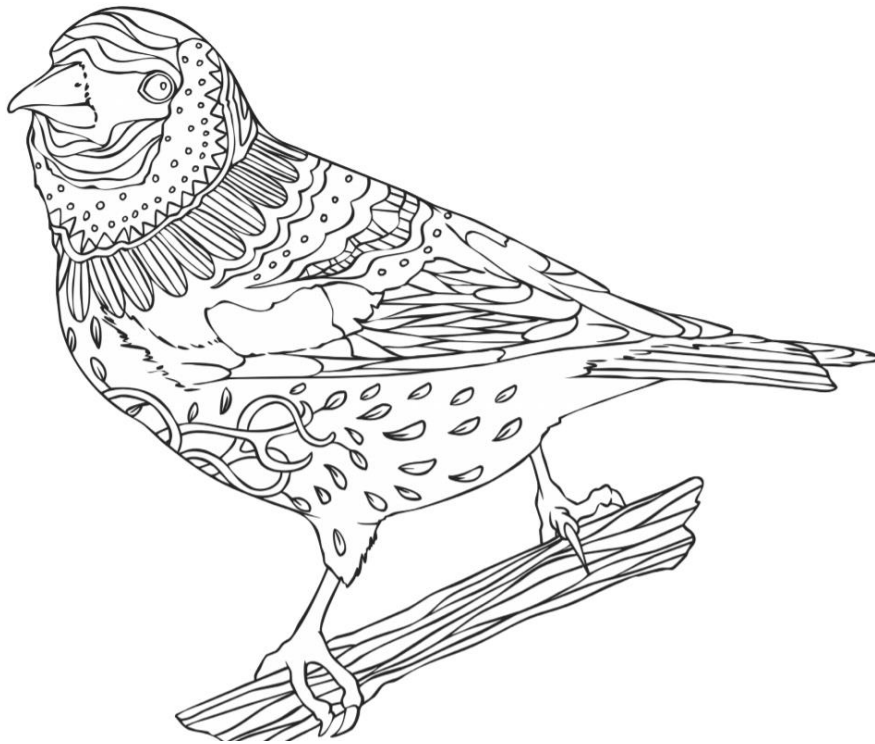
From the birds on the sheet above use the RSPB website to find out information about each bird.

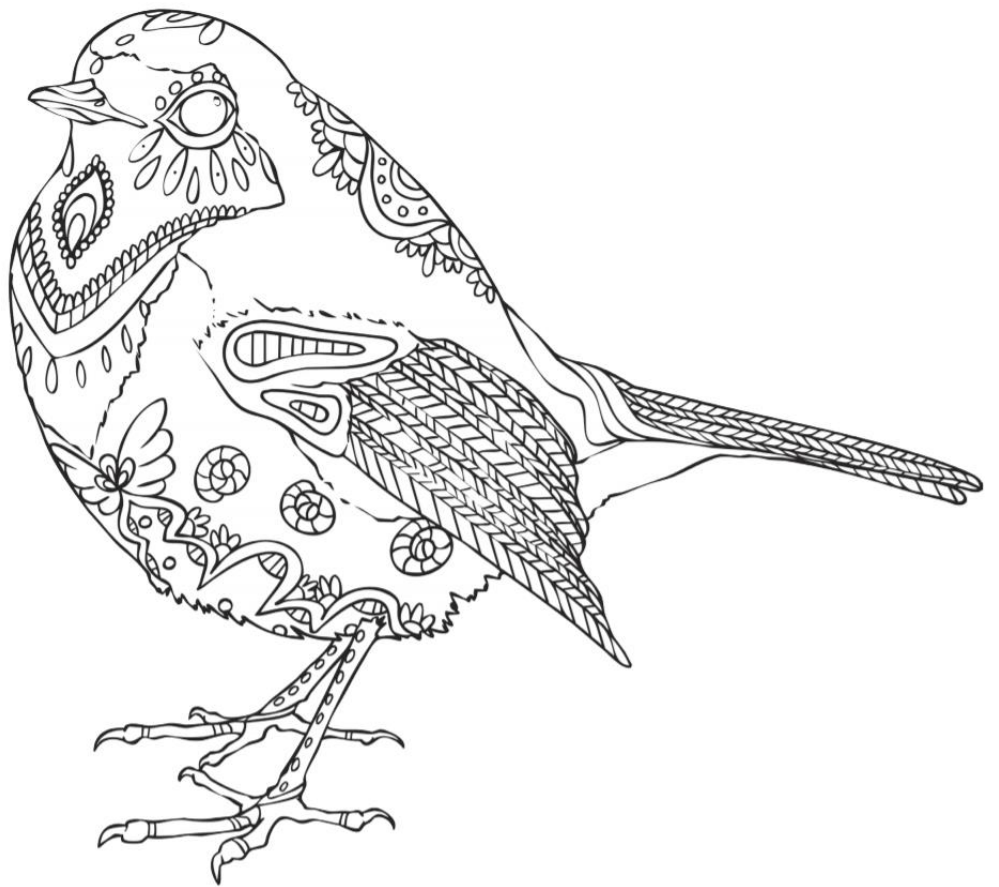
Record the following information.

Mammal Usually have hair or fur give birth to live young mammals that live on land have 4 legs (except humans) they are warm blooded	Bird they have feathers and wings, they have 2 legs, they lay eggs they are warm blooded	Reptile they have scales, not fur, they have dry skin, they have 4 legs or no legs, they are cold blooded	Insect they are very small, they sometimes have wings, they have more than 4 legs, they can have a body that is in 3 parts
