



St Philip's Y7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium: impact statement 2019-20

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives state-funded schools, including special schools and alternative provision settings, additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

The funding received has contributed to the employment of additional maths and literacy teachers. This has enabled St Philip's to:

- Reduce year 7 English and maths class sizes by 25% in comparison to the rest of the school.
- Carry out baseline assessments for all year 7 pupils in maths (Sandwell) and English (DRA)
- Offer one to one maths and English interventions for those who have the most significant gaps in their learning.

As a result:

Due to COVID 19 it was not possible to carry out end of year assessments and therefore specific data on impact is not available. Teacher assessment and parent and student feedback indicates that 97% of students have made good or better progress in maths and English.
